6B) TREASURERS REPORT AND FUND TRANSFER: Trustee Hower moved to approve the March Treasurers Report, with receipts of \$2,336,467.58, disbursements of \$1,506,498.87, leaving a balance of \$829,968.71. ACH Payments scheduled for \$1,451,932.29 and \$9,659.32 coming out of the utility account. Trustee Hill second. Upon roll call the following answered:

6C) TREASURERS REPORT AND FUND TRANSFER - Trustee Hower moved to transfer

\$790,000 from the Checking Account to the Money Market account, \$48,000 from the ambulance account to the Money Market account, \$8,685.89 from the Money Market account to the Utility account. Trustee Long second. Upon roll call the following answered

The cost of Station 3 to date is \$5,455,618.17, with still \$700,000.00 yet to pay, station 3 is going to cost approximately 6,000,000.000.

7A) PUBLIC INFORMATION REPORT -A written report was provided.

8) REPORT BY CHIEF AND ASST. CHIEFS – Mike De Silvestro, PSI, stated the District is down 2 full time staff members. They are making good progress on the part time apprentice program. Mike reviewed the part time apprentice program giving them limited access to the firehouse, and sending them to EMT School. They will be full fledge firefighters within 3 years. A draft of the program will be presented at the next meeting. Background check and interviews will be required. PSI has a zero tolerance policy for marijuana. PSI will provide marketing materials and schedule visits to the schools.

The turnover rate is down this year. The Trustees requested a 90 day rolling average for turnover rate for the District.

Chief Kreher stated the cost of an ambulance is increasing and suggested the District order the new ambulance now, the current price is \$378,000.00. Trustee Hower is tracking the expenses in the budget process. This will be on the agenda next month.

April 4, is the official opening for the new station.
